Background

Following an incident involving the Waste Transfer Station automatic door, additional access controls are being reinforced to ensure safe entry and exit from the area.

Key message

The following rules shall apply to all DIA personnel / tenants / contractors accessing the Waste Transfer station.

Action Required:

To prevent crush injuries, vehicle–pedestrian conflicts, and entrapment:

- Enter or exit the waste transfer area ONLY when the automatic door is fully open.
- Do NOT enter or exit when the door is closing or set to close.
- Never attempt to force the door, block sensors, or bypass controls.
- Wait until the door has fully opened and the area is clear before proceeding.
- Do not access the Waste Transfer Station when a vehicle is operating in the area.
- Never walk behind or beside a reversing vehicle.
- Report any malfunctioning doors, hazards, or unsafe conditions immediately to the TA00 on duty.



Safety is everyone's responsibility.

Taking a few extra seconds to follow the correct procedure can prevent serious injury.
