There are three front of house (FOH) lanes for the DIA terminal, the first is the drop off lane for restricted services, the second is for taxi's only and the third is for members of the public drop off lane. Recently the signage has been upgraded to reflect these 3 lanes as being shared zones between the Arrivals and Departures breezeways (photo below refers).

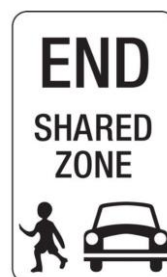


A shared zone means the speed in these lanes reduces to 10 km/hr and that vehicles must give way to pedestrians.
