Introduction

As the vehicular traffic in the front of house (FOH) lanes continues to increase with the air movements at the terminal it is timely to remind road users be aware of the road usage rules.

The FOH Express Drop-off lane **MUST only be used for dropping people off** at the airport and then leaving. This enables the traffic to keep flowing and ensures the safety of pedestrians & vehicles alike, particularly during peak periods. Vehicles standing in the drop off lane creates a traffic hazard for vehicles that are trying to use the Drop off lane facility (photo refers).

Recently vehicles have been seen waiting in the drop off lane while a person goes into the terminal and awaits their return before leaving &/or double parking in the lane. These are illegal activities and people found doing this, particularly during busy periods, will be fined.

Action

- All vehicles using the terminal are reminded to heed the rules in regard to the Express Drop-off lane.
- Security and Safety personnel will be randomly auditing the area &
- People failing to comply will be fined,
- Repeat Offenders that are business related may be restricted from trading at airport.
