## Personnel changes

## Conditions of Use – Moving Aircraft

NTA reviews its Conditions of Use for Darwin, Alice Springs and Tennant Creek annually to ensure the accuracy of the terms and conditions upon which we supply aviation services, government mandated services and general airport services to you, under the lease granted by the Commonwealth, including the updated Aviation Charges effective from 01 July 2019 (refer Schedule 2 – Aviation Charges); and the conditions that govern the use of NT Airports by Aircraft Operators and other Users.

The most recent change to the CoU document includes clarification with regards to the cost of operational response requirements after an emergency situation has eventuated on the movement area, in particular the need for the moving of aircraft, including the costs of crane or other equipment required in the removal of a disabled aircraft being borne by the aircraft operator – refer item **11. Moving Aircraft**.

Following debrief/reviews of previous emergency response events, DIA has amended the crane call-out process. When an aircraft emergency situation arises resulting in a disabled aircraft blocking a section of the movement area, the Operations team will immediately initiate the crane call-out, regardless if the crane will actually be required to be used or not. This is implemented to put the Operations team on the front foot when it comes to prompt and safe recovery of the movement area and keeping disruption of airport operations to a minimum.

## Working on Airport Requirements - Induction changes

A new induction is currently being rolled out **NTA Working on Airport**, this induction and awareness package replaces and combines existing and new inductions (e.g. Contractor Induction, DAMP, Airside Safety and Biosecurity Induction).

The Working on Airport Induction is required to be completed by all persons who work on Darwin Airport.

The new induction will take approximately 35 minutes to complete and is required to be completed on a 2-yearly basis i.e. will be required to be completed as part of the process for all new ASIC (or Access Control) applications (initial and renewals).
